ATTENTION PARENTS AND STUDENTS: Please read through the Science Fair Guide and Demonstration Guide for important information on what must be included in your project!

A limited supply of guides will be available in the office if you do NOT have computer access.

Projects CANNOT use microorganisms, per NC State Science Fair rules. If your experiment uses animals, recombinant DNA, tissue samples, or relies on observing or testing other humans, you will need to complete and sign an extra form, if your project is chosen to go to the regional fair. See the guide for details.

Science fair projects can be either experimental or demonstration projects. Experimental projects are hypothesis driven and answer a question through testing of various scenarios. Demonstration projects, on the other hand, explain or illustrate a scientific principle or concept without asking a question. Only experimental projects will be eligible to compete at the regional level.
