Our teachers are busy, using recent CASE 21 data to guide them in providing instruction that will help students meet goals before EOGs and the end of the year. Please ask your child's teacher if you have any questions about the recent report cards or CASE 21 data. Also, all students will be assessed on reading skills for a final benchmarking period beginning May 11th. EOG testing will begin the week of May 18th. We always need proctors for these exams. If any parents are willing to proctor, please contact Mary Alice Ramsey, our testing coordinator, to volunteer. Parents must be a registered volunteer to be able to help and the system is open only on Mondays at this point in the year.

I am so pleased to tell you that a recommendation has been made for our vacant Assistant Principal position. This recommendation will be presented to the Wake County School Board tonight. I will send a voice mail to families with more information as soon as I am able.

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walking or biking to school or at school with the AHA Wellness Star. Since Swift Creek Elementary is located in an area that is not conducive to students walking or biking to and from school, our PTA Healthy Lifestyles Committee brainstormed ways to engage students in walking at school. The Walking Wednesdays program is a voluntary program for all students and staff. Every Wednesday, they are encouraged to spend their entire recess walking or running around our track. Laps are tracked and tallied by the Healthy Lifestyles committee. Participants are then rewarded with "walking tokens" for every 10 laps (2 miles) cumulatively walked. The classroom that earns the most walking tokens by the end of the year will receive a coveted gold trophy. Participation levels vary within each class, with some classrooms having 100% participation. On any given week, the average school-wide participation approaches 50%, which amounts to over 250 participants. Our students and staff are very excited about this program and we are looking forward to seeing who earns that gold trophy. We thank Lisa Barrangou and her Healthy Lifestyles Committee for all their work with this program. We would not have received this award without their legwork and brainpower.

Our PTA is always working collaboratively behind the scenes to provide programs for our students. At our last PTA meeting, the Executive Board shared the vacant chair positions for next year. Please consider serving in one of these crucial roles for our school. Without your help, we will not be able to implement the same programming. There is a sign up poster on the wall outside of our counselor's office for your consideration. We appreciate your help and service always!
