
event in May. Join me in congratulating her and thanking her for her service!

The site has links to the district snapshots for each school and will also share the "School Performance Grades" for each school in our state. These "grades" were calculated from a formula combining EOG proficiency scores and growth scores for elementary schools. As these "single" grades are released to the public for last school year, please know that it is difficult to measure a school with a single grade. A single grade for the entire school does not account for the complexity of all of our children at Swift Creek. Furthermore, one letter grade cannot accurately reflect the heart and soul of a school, its progress towards goals and objectives, or take into consideration the plethora of variables that affect student outcomes. At Swift Creek, we have shared pertinent data with you and will continue to use our data to make instructional decisions, identify areas for improvement, as well as to our celebrate successes. We will also continue to love and support your children as always and will
