It's Time for the Science Fair!!! January 12, 2017

Attention all Swifties! This year's Swift Creek Elementary School Science Fair will be held on Thursday, January 12, 2017 in the cafeteria. The upcoming Holiday break is a perfect time to work on those experimental projects or demonstrations.

Here is how our Science Fair is run:

Volunteer judges with STEM backgrounds from the community judge all of our projects (we have both demonstration and experimental project categories). Up to three first - third place and unlimited honorable mention medals can be awarded per grade (depending on our partition numbers). All participants also receive prizes. In addition, the judges pick the three best overall projects. These receive "Best in Show" trophies. "Best in Show" experimental projects are eligible for entry into the regional fair. Swift Creek covers the registration fee for the regional fair and I will provide an information sheet to "Best in Show" parents detailing how to register for the regional fair. We also have a recognition ceremony on the evening of the Science Fair where I am available in person to answer any questions parents may have.
