- Kindergarten registration is open now. We want to make sure we are on top of our registration. Please send any families our way who will have a kindergartener next year.
- After school care We currently do not have enough students to support after school care. We had funds to float the program until January when 4th and 5th graders return. We will know in January whether we will be able to continue the program.
- New way to communicate with school staff On our website, if you click on contact us, there is an online form called Let's Talk. It's a way for you to offer a suggestion, idea, compliment, etc. It will be routed to the appropriate staff.
- We have hired a brand new PE teacher. We miss Ms. Graves! Mr. Trey Hines will be joining us in January! He is young, full of energy and excited to join our team!
- We are in the search for a new 5th grade teacher. We will have 3 5th grade teachers! We have interviewed a couple of candidates so far and I'm hoping to have more information come January.
- The window for registering for virtual academy ends December 9th. One question I keep getting is "Will teacher _____ be teacher virtual or in-person next semester?" That is a question I cannot answer. We need to wait and see how the numbers work out.
- When will we know if our child will have a different teacher? We will probably have the data by the end of this week. The following week we will look at how kids will fit into classes to decide how best to work it out. We will probably have information by the first week of January.
