The "Orff" approach allows everyone to be actively engaged in the music making process through singing, movement, playing instruments, or creating. When we are actively engaged in music making and learning, we build a foundation of discovery, creativity, problem solving and more. We also learn that music is a life-long process of growth and change.

Valuable life-long music making and learning happens through authentic and frequent experiences throughout a child's life. I encourage all SCES families to take time to actively participate and create music together. Creating songs in the car, hosting a family concert, adding sound effects when reading books, or communicating without words just sounds are great ways to participate in the music making every day.

Let's keep our bodies strong and healthy for LIFE






We Won a Healthy Schools Grant!
