District 5 Board Advisory Council Meeting

The last District 5 Board Advisory Council for the 2016-17 school year was held Tuesday, May 2nd at Washington Elementary. Bob Grant, Principal of Washington Elementary shared about the school's programs and history and stated that it was the second magnet school in the county. Three members of the Pitt County Board of Education were present to learn how Wake County operates its advisory boards. Karen Ivanhoff, an at-large District 5 member was elected as the District 5 chair for the 2017-18 school year. Dr. James Martin, District 5 Board of Education Member, shared that WCPSS's proposed budget will include a \$10 Million request for social workers and guidance counselors. The meeting focused on "Discipline Beyond Punishment" and had attendees review three case studies on student behavior and discipline.
